 they should be washed daily. If you need a spare or two to allow for washing and
 wearing, check in with the office.
- Please note that our drop-off times are 7:45-8:00am for the morning crew and 12:15-12:30pm for the afternoon bunch. Please do not drop your child off any earlier than this time; there is not adult supervision outside, and students are not permitted to enter the building until 7:45/12:15.
- If your child arrives late to school or if you are picking them early, please use the main office doors. The other doors are locked and are not supervised outside of the dropoff window
- Thank you for sharing your kids with us! Our staff is thrilled to see them in the building!
