Classroom Structures

Here are steps we are taking to keep kids distant!

Classrooms have decided they are going to do pods of kids (with 6 feet distancing between pods) or every child 3 feet apart if not podded. Many classrooms choose to pod due to the instructional benefit of keeping kids in groups within the same room. Students will go to special locations for their special instruction, which our Art, PE, Music, Social/Emotional Learning and Library are very happy about. In each area kids will have assigned seats, to be by the same kids they are near in their classroom. Cubbies are being marked for each classroom and we have tried to provide one cubby between kids and they will go to their cubbies in two groups.

Mikaela Lee is our social worker. She had a great summer, she got to nanny her niece and she went to Disney World for a fun vacation. Mikaela works with kids on an individual basis, and in groups, as well as in a full classroom to help develop social skills and emotional intelligence. She also connects families in the community to help support needs in and out of school. Mikaela helps to develop school culture such as implementing movement hallways. More to come next month.
